Sundays at 4 p.m.

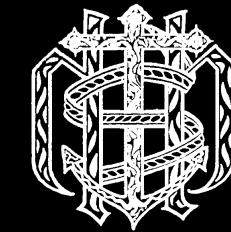
During the month of July, each Sunday will feature a nationally known carillonneur on our Noyes Memorial Carillon. Recitals begin at 4 p.m.
